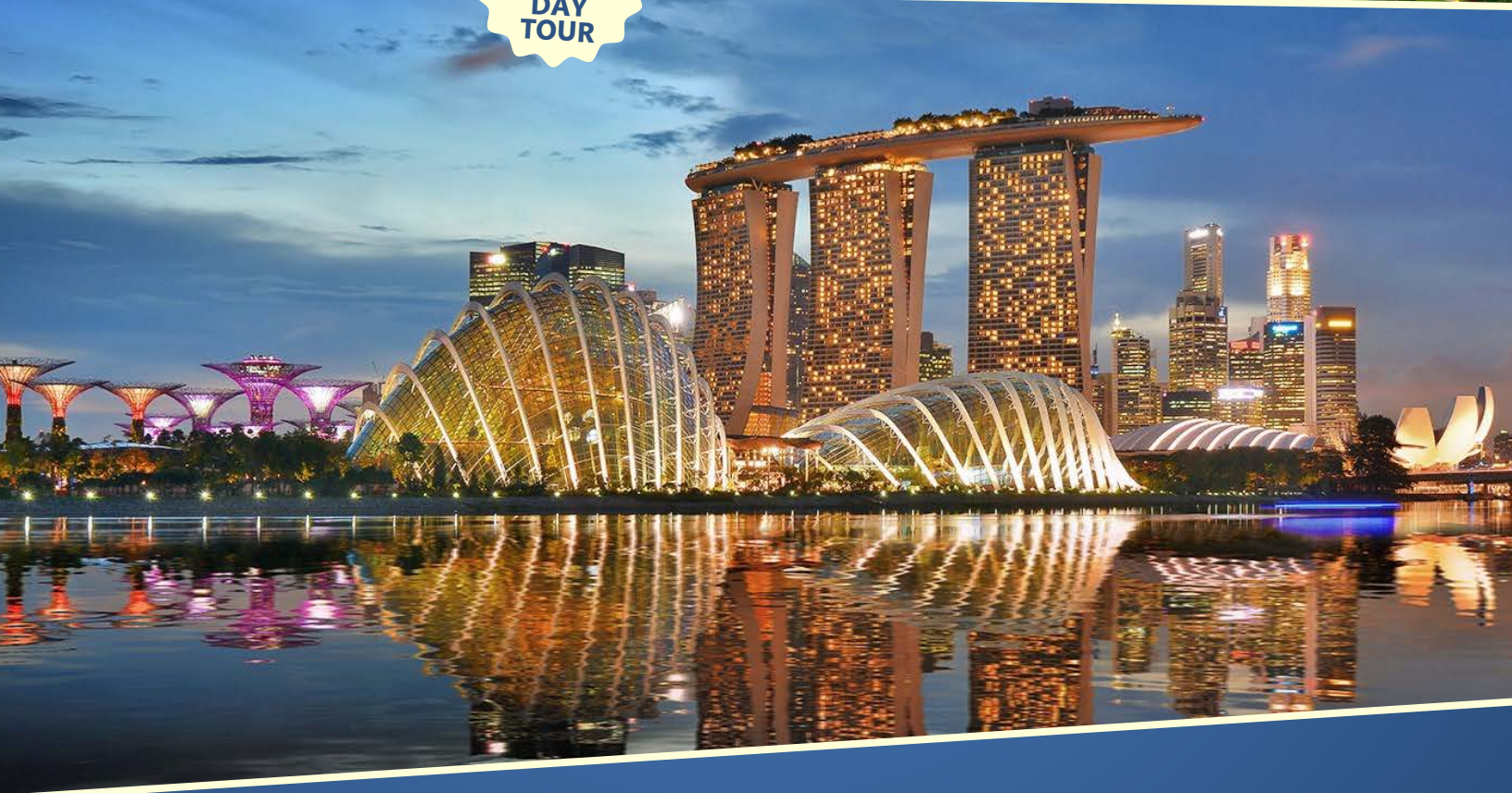

DAY 1: PITTSBURGH - KUALA LUMPUR

Arrive in time at Pittsburgh International Airport to check-in and board your overnight flight to Kuala Lumpur, Malaysia's capital. Enjoy inflight meals and services.

DAY 3: KUALA LUMPUR ARRIVAL (-/-)

Upon arrival in Kuala Lumpur, you will be met by our representative and transferred to your hotel. Enjoy your rest of the day at leisure.

DAY 4: KUALA LUMPUR (B/-/D)

Start your day exploring Kuala Lumpur—fondly known as “KL”—a city where modern marvels meet rich heritage. Your journey begins at the Petronas Twin Towers, the tallest twin towers in the world, soaring to 452 meters (1,483 feet). These postmodern architectural icons are Malaysia's proud symbol of progress. With included entrance to the Skybridge (41st floor) and the Observation Deck (86th floor), you'll enjoy breathtaking panoramic views of KL's skyline. Next, visit Batu Caves, Malaysia's most iconic Hindu shrines, located within the limestone hills of Batu Caves. A climb of 272 steps leads to the impressive Temple Cave, home to several Hindu shrines and statues. Return to Kuala Lumpur and continue your adventure with visits to some of the city's most celebrated landmarks: King's Palace (Istana Negara) – a photo stop at the official residence of Malaysia's monarch. Merdeka Square – the historic site where Malaysia declared independence, surrounded by colonial-era architecture. Central Market – a vibrant hub for local crafts and souvenirs, perfect for picking up a memento of your trip. This tour blends iconic sights with cultural highlights, offering a perfect introduction to Kuala Lumpur's charm. Afternoon will be at leisure. In the evening, enjoy a memorable dining experience at Orbit Revolving Dining at KL Tower, where the restaurant slowly rotates to offer stunning 360-degree views of Kuala Lumpur's glittering skyline. Located atop the iconic KL Tower, the dinner combines an elegant buffet spread with breathtaking panoramic scenery, creating a perfect blend of fine cuisine and unforgettable city views. Overnight in Kuala Lumpur.

DAY 5: KUALA LUMPUR (B/-/D)

Enjoy breakfast at the hotel. The morning is free for you to relax or explore at your own leisure. At 4:00 PM, depart from the hotel and transfer to Selangor (approximately a 1-hour journey) for an enchanting evening nature experience. Upon arrival, enjoy early dinner at a local restaurant. After dinner, embark on a memorable fireflies boat tour along the mangrove-lined

Selangor River. Witness thousands of fireflies glowing in perfect synchrony, illuminating the trees like sparkling Christmas lights — a truly magical and serene spectacle unique to this region. Following the fireflies experience, continue to observe the fascinating “Blue Tears” phenomenon. As the water is gently disturbed, bioluminescent plankton emit a vivid blue glow, creating a mesmerizing effect that resembles stars shimmering in the river. At approximately 10:00 PM, transfer back to the hotel.

Overnight stay in Kuala Lumpur.

Note: The Fireflies and Blue Tears tour is subject to weather and tidal conditions.



DAY 6: KUALA LUMPUR - GENTING HIGHLANDS (B/-/-)

After breakfast, depart for Genting Highlands on a scenic drive of approximately two hours (subject to traffic conditions). Upon arrival at the Genting Skyway cable car station, your luggage will be transferred separately to the resort hotel by vehicle. Enjoy a spectacular cable car ride ascending to the hilltop resort, offering panoramic views of the surrounding rainforest (subject to weather conditions and maintenance schedules). Upon arrival, proceed to your hotel for check-in and take time to relax and enjoy the refreshing mountain atmosphere. Overnight stay at Genting Highlands.

DAY 7: GENTING HIGHLANDS (B/-/-)

DAY 8: GENTING HIGHLAND - KUALA LUMPUR - PENANG (B/-/-)

Transfer to Kuala Lumpur International Airport (KLIA) to board your flight to Penang. Known as the “Pearl of the Orient,” Penang beautifully blends rich cultural heritage with vibrant modern life. From the UNESCO-listed streets of George Town to its world-famous street food scene, the island offers travellers an unforgettable mix of history, flavors, and local charm. Upon arrival, you will be met and transferred to your hotel for check-in. The remainder of the day is free at leisure to relax or enjoy the beach at your beachside boutique resort at your own pace. Overnight in Penang.

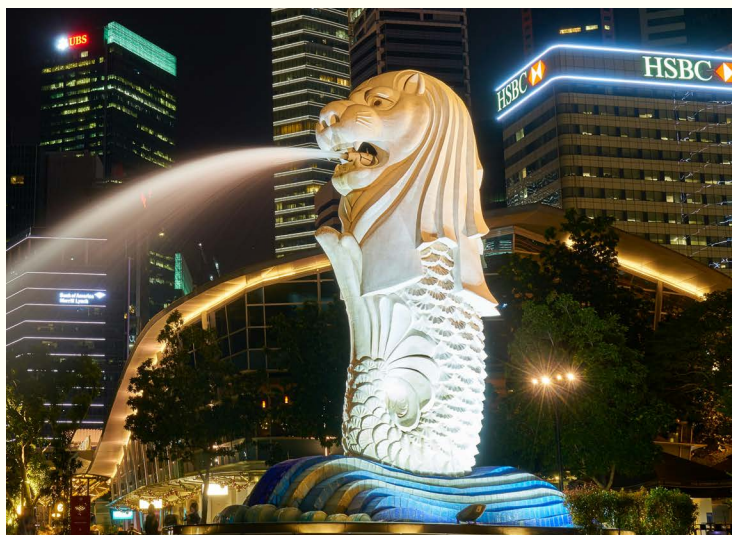
DAY 9: DISCOVERY TOUR OF GEORGETOWN, PENANG (B/-/-)

In the morning, depart from hotel for a City, Culture, and Heritage tour of Georgetown, which has been official declared as a UNESCO SITE in 2008. Visit the 3rd longest reclining Buddha figure in the world followed by Kek Lok Si Temple, also known as Temple of 1000 Buddhas, that was built in 1904. It is the most beautiful and largest Buddhist temple complex in SouthEast Asia. Next we visit Fort Cornwallis, the landing site of Captain Francis Light in 1786 when he arrived to start the first British colony in Penang. The tour carries on with a visit to the water village of The Clan Jetties at Weld Quay, so named as residents of each jetty share similar surname. We next take you along Pitt Street, also known as “The Street of Harmony”. Here churches, Chinese temples, mosques and Hindu temples

are built along the same street in harmonious existence side by side for centuries. Visit the intricate Khoo Kong Si clan's house. Enjoy a breezy trishaw ride, a still popular mode of transport in Georgetown. Return to the hotel and the rest of the day is at your own leisure. Enjoy the beach, in the late evening, you can explore the nightlife along Batu Ferringhi, Penang style! Overnight in Penang

DAY 10: PENANG - SINGAPORE (B/-)

In time, transfer to Penang Airport for your flight to Singapore. Upon arrival, you will be met and transferred to your hotel for check-in. The remainder of the day is at leisure to relax or explore the city at your own pace. You may choose to visit Sentosa Island, enjoy a traditional bumboat ride along the Singapore River, shop along the famous Orchard Road, or explore cultural and historical attractions such as the National Museum of Singapore or the Asian Civilisations Museum. Alternatively, discover the vibrant Kampong Glam district or unwind with dining and drinks at the lively waterfront areas of Clarke Quay, Boat Quay, or Robertson Quay. Overnight in Singapore.



DAY 11: SINGAPORE (B/-)

Experience the vibrant blend of history, culture, and modernity on this comprehensive Singapore City Tour, offering an introduction to the city's iconic landmarks and multicultural heritage. The tour begins with a scenic drive through Singapore's historic Civic District, where you will see some of the nation's most important colonial-era landmarks. Pass by the Parliament House, the Former City Hall and Supreme Court — now home to the National Gallery Singapore — as well as the historic Padang and the beautiful St. Andrew's Cathedral. You will also view the Former Fullerton Building, once Singapore's General Post Office and today a celebrated heritage landmark. Continue to Merlion Park for a memorable photo stop with Singapore's famous Merlion statue, the symbolic half-lion, half-fish icon representing the city's origins as a fishing village and its transformation into a global metropolis. Next, explore the lively district of Chinatown, where Singapore's early migrant heritage comes alive. Visit the impressive Buddha Tooth Relic Temple & Museum and stroll along Pagoda Street, lined with traditional shophouses, local markets, and cultural souvenirs. The journey continues to Kampung Glam, Singapore's historic Malay and Arab quarter. Admire the magnificent Sultan Mosque and enjoy free time to explore the colorful Haji Lane and Bussorah Street, known for their vibrant cafés, boutiques, and street art. The tour concludes with a visit to the lush Singapore Botanic Gardens, a UNESCO World Heritage Site. Within the gardens, discover the renowned National Orchid Garden, home to an extraordinary collection of orchids showcasing Singapore's national flower and rich biodiversity. This city tour provides the perfect overview of Singapore's cultural diversity, colonial history, and modern charm — ideal for first-time visitors.
