**Day 1: Thursday, November 5, 2026 Overnight Flight** It's time to live the good life and embark on a getaway to the fabulous French Riviera, or *Côte d'Azur*. Its elegant coastal resorts, superb eateries, chic boutiques, and captivating museums make it the ultimate sunny retreat for the elite. Unpack your bags just once and stay at a single hotel for your entire adventure, which begins with an overnight flight to France.

**Day 2: Friday, November 6, 2026 Nice (French Riviera), France** Your tour commences in the stunning city of Nice, a coastal pearl of the Mediterranean known for its legendary opulence and balmy beaches. With an average of 300 sunny days per year, Nice is a seaside paradise. As arrival times will vary, there is no scheduled sightseeing today. Spend the day as you wish, exploring the city independently. This evening, join your fellow travelers for a welcome dinner in *Vieux Nice* featuring Mediterranean-inspired French cuisine. (D)

**Day 3: Saturday, November 7, 2026 Nice** Get around like a local by navigating the tram this morning. Get familiar with the tramway routes to use to your advantage in your free time later. With a local expert, discover Nice by meandering through the city's famed and colorful flower market. Then, delve into the Old Town, sampling local delicacies while on a tasting tour. The rest of the day is yours. Perhaps you'll return to your hotel and stroll along the lively seafront *Promenade des Anglais*. You may even stay downtown and visit one of Nice's world-class art galleries, such as the Chagall or the Matisse museums. Maybe you'll find your favorite café for the week and soak in the local life. (B, L)

**Day 4: Sunday, November 8, 2026 Nice - Monaco - Nice** Travel along the spectacular *Corniche* coastal road to the Principality of Monaco. On a walking tour, view the changing of the guards and visit the Cathedral of Monaco — the permanent resting place of Prince Rainier III and Princess Grace. Then **it's your choice!** Visit the Prince's Palace of Monaco to tour this grand residence **-OR-** hop on a "little train" tour,\* taking in Monaco's history and sights, including views of Monte Carlo Casino. (B)

**Day 5: Monday, November 9, 2026 Nice - Saint-Jean-Cap-Ferrat - Èze - Nice** This morning, head to Saint-Jean-Cap-Ferrat, referred to as the crown jewel of the French Riviera. Learn the secrets of perfume making during a hands-on workshop and tour of the Fragonard perfumery, where fragrant formulations have been prepared since 1782. Spend time soaking up the atmosphere of a *Provençal* hill town: the medieval village of Èze. Explore the village's timeless charm and the Exotic Garden before returning to Nice. (B, D)

**Day 6: Tuesday, November 10, 2026 Nice - St. Honorat Island - Cannes - Nice** Journey to Cannes and sail\*\* across the Bay of Cannes to the tiny island of Saint-Honorat, belonging to the monks of Lérins Abbey. Pause to taste the locally produced wine before returning to Cannes to perhaps rub elbows with Europe's elite. Walk in the footsteps of celebrities when you see the Film Festival Palace and the iconic red carpet featured during the Cannes Film Festival. During free time, explore the cobbled lanes of the *Le Suquet* neighborhood or the lively Forville farmers' market. This evening, savor a tasting menu highlighting the delights of the south of France. (B, D)

**Day 7: Wednesday, November 11, 2026 Nice - Optional Excursion to Italy** The day is yours! Enjoy your free time relaxing and taking in the laid-back atmosphere along the Riviera. Perhaps you'll join an optional excursion that takes you to discover Dolceacqua, a gem of the Italian Riviera nestled in the mountains, before savoring the local cuisine during an included lunch. (B)

## Important Tour Information:

The overall activity level of this tour is a level 3. This means you're an on-the-go traveler. You don't want to miss a thing, so walking and standing for longer periods of time (2-3 hours) isn't a big deal. A moderately paced two-and-a-half-hour walking tour, covering several miles, hills, and uneven surfaces, is no problem for you. Walking four miles over the course of a day is very doable, as is climbing into and out of various modes of transportation (tuk-tuk, cable car, zodiac, etc.). You can climb three flights of stairs easily and handle altitudes between 6,000 and 9,000 feet. Expect some longer days with early mornings or late nights balanced with free time to recharge or set out on your own adventure. This level is not a fit for travelers who require mobility assistance devices.

Some of the most unique sightseeing can mean accessing locations that restrict motor coaches, especially in historic areas such as the Old Town of Nice, Monaco, Saint-Honorat Island, and St. Paul de Vence. If you require a walker or wheelchair, or have difficulty walking, you may not be able to access some of these areas and may want to consider an alternate tour with us. Our Client Care Agents can provide additional information or assistance to help you determine the perfect trip for you.

If you require any special assistance while on tour, please make us aware at the time of reservation so the necessary request form can be sent to your attention.

Your visits to Monaco, the Gardens of Villa Rothschild, and St. Paul de Vence village involve negotiating some steep inclines over cobblestones, gravel, or multiple flights of steps.

\*\*The Saint-Honorat Island cruise operates weather permitting, depending on sea conditions. If it is not operating, an alternative visit in Cannes will be arranged as a replacement.

\*The Little Train tour operates from February to mid-November. In the other months, travelers selecting this choice will transfer to the Monte Carlo district by public bus.

Single accommodations are limited and are available on a first-come, first-served basis. Single rate subject to change based on availability.

To complete your tour, we include round-trip airport-to-hotel transfers when purchasing our airfare with your tour. If you have arranged for your own air, we are pleased to provide you the option of *purchasing* these transfers. Please note that all transfers will leave at pre-scheduled times.

## Travel Requirements:
